The great question remains: How to react to the demise of these assumptions? In response, the essays develop a concerted, evolving approach to the possibilities--and limitations--of constructive philosophies of mathematics and mind. Their collection constitutes a major statement by one of Britain's most important philosophers--and will provide an indispensable tool both for students of Wittgenstein and for scholars working more generally in the metaphysics of mind and language.

**Love's Knowledge** Sep 23 2019 This volume brings together Nussbaum's published papers on the relationship between literature and philosophy, especially moral philosophy.
